Maintenance Director Skip Martin introduced Mike Corcoran, Maintenance Mechanic II, for his five years of service. Mr. Martin said that Mr. Corcoran brings lots of experience and knowledge to their department and keeps our small engines running. The Commissioners thanked Mr. Corcoran for all he does and hopes he will be around a lot longer and appreciates the skills he has. Mr. Corcoran thanked the current and previous Commissioners and the current and previous Chief Clerks for their support and said he enjoys his job.

Conservation District Manager Jamie Knecht introduced Zach Jones, Nutrient Management Specialist, to recognize his five years of service. Ms. Knecht called him the department go to guy and they are lucky to have him on their staff. He plays so many roles and is well liked. The Commissioners praised Mr. Jones’ professionalism, involvement and knowledge and said the County is truly blessed to have him on their staff. Mr. Jones said he likes his job and is thankful for the opportunity to serve and help others who have the same issues and questions he had as a farmer.

Wayne County Human Services Administrator Michelle Valinski, Wayne County Behavioral Health Director Margaret Ennis, Behavioral Health Alliance of Rural Pennsylvania CEO Sally Walker and Behavioral Health Alliance of Rural Pennsylvania COO Curt Proctor, were present to talk about the Behavioral Health Alliance of Rural Pennsylvania (BHARP) contract.

Margaret Ennis said Wayne County along with 23 other counties are members of the Behavioral Health Alliance of Rural Pennsylvania (BHARP) for management care with Behavioral Health and Drug and Alcohol Services. Ms. Ennis said they decided to join in because of the competency of the behavioral rural leadership. Curt Proctor and Sally Walker explained the history of behavioral rural, the role it plays and gave a brief presentation.

Commissioner Smith said this is a complicated arrangement but integral to so many thousands of lives. Commissioner Smith thanked them for their presentation and for what they do for these very vulnerable populations. Commissioner Cramer thanked Margaret Ennis, Michelle Valinski and Jeff Zerechek for what they do for the County, their staff and consumers. Commissioner Adams said the entire team is so compassionate, capable and passionate and knows it is a demanding job. He said hats off to them for the things they do. Commissioner Adams said he knows it is overwhelming sometimes, but the County is fortunate to have them in their place.

Chris Barrett, Bryan Bossuyt and Marlyn Kissner were on hand from the Pocono Mountain Visitors Bureau to present the quarterly report. Chris Barrett, President and CEO of the Pocono Mountain Visitors Bureau, gave a PowerPoint presentation on efforts in 2021 by his organization. He said the hotel tax was up to \$14 million collected. He attributed that to people wanting to get away after COVID, but not wanting to have to fly or travel internationally. He thinks the same will be true in 2022 and noted that the 2021 media spending in Wayne County alone, totaled \$696,875 and that \$88,683 from hotel tax revenues were awarded as grants in Wayne County. Marlyn Kissner, Vice President of Membership and Community Relations, said the Pocono Mountain Visitors Bureau has 474 total members, 71 of which are

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in Wayne County. The Commissioners thanked them for their very detailed presentation and for their constant promotion of the Wayne County tourism industry. Conservation District Director Jamie Knecht provided the 2021 Conservation District Annual Report.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to approve a letter of support for the Wayne County Conservation District's grant application to the Pennsylvania American Water 2022 Environmental Grant program in the amount of \$9,794 for an educational and training program focused on building better watershed resilience using a stream model table.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to ratify a letter of support for Honesdale Borough's application for a trails grant through the statewide LSA and pledging a county financial commitment in the amount of \$25,000 toward the project.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to approve the 1st Quarter Children and Youth Services for the period of July 1, 2021-September 30, 2021.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to approve acceptance of a \$22,400 PEMA grant for Statewide Interconnectivity Funding toward NextGen 911 projects.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to certify the 2021 Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Preparedness report and to submit to PEMA.

A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to ratify the judicial hiring of Nick Sanseverino as a Juvenile Probation Officer, effective March 28, 2022.
