

The regular meeting of the Wayne County Commissioners was held on this date with Commissioner Brian W. Smith presiding. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith with Commissioner Joseph W. Adams and Commissioner Jocelyn Cramer present.

The Commissioners were presented with a copy of the minutes from the meeting held March 18, 2021. A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to approve the minutes of the said meeting.

Agenda

Scheduled to meet with the Commissioners: Wayne County Director of Tax Services Cheryl Davies and Mary Noldy, Project Manager from Tyler Technologies, for the reassessment plan.

Correspondence and Communications

Received a letter from Aterra Solutions, LLC, regarding an NPDES permit application to DEP on behalf of the PA Fish and Boat Commission, regarding Miller Pond Dam, Mount Pleasant Township.

Received notice from DEP that a Virtual Public Meeting will be held March 30, 2021, at 6:30 p.m., in reference to the Skinners Falls Bridge Planning Study.

Received a letter from Robert J. Suhosky opposing the 10 ton weight limit the PA Department of Transportation has placed on the Owego Turnpike.

Received a notice from Richard Roman, P.E., PennDOT Engineering District 4 District Executive, responding to the County's request for a meeting on the Owego Turnpike weight limit restriction. The Chief Clerk noted the County has accepted the offer and has scheduled a meeting March 26, 2021 to discuss the weight limit posting.

Received a letter from the District Court Administrator stating Caitlyn Tallerico has withdrawn her acceptance of the Law Clerk position. A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to accept the withdrawal offer.

Public Comment

James Sellars and Jason Brett Corbett presented a petition with 900 signatures requesting the commissioners pass a resolution making Wayne County a Second Amendment Sanctuary County. If they are not interested, at least pass a resolution like some other counties have to standup for the Second Amendment. Seventeen (17) other counties have adopted a similar resolution.

Commissioner Smith said he is seriously in favor of the Second Amendment and has given multiple speeches about it. Commissioner Smith said there has to be checks and balances in place. The position of the County Commissioners is administrative in function not legislative. For us to try to legislate would just be giving you lip service. The Commissioners have all sworn an oath to protect the United States and Pennsylvania Constitutions and the

Commissioners do just that. Commissioner Smith said they are happy to promote and protect the Second Amendment and believe it is what they do.

Commissioner Adams noted the United States and Pennsylvania Constitutions have stood the test of time for well over 200 years, with 7 articles and 27 amendments in the federal constitution and with 11 articles and 46 amendments in the state constitution. Each of us have sworn an oath to support and obey and defend every one of those. Commissioner Adams firmly believes in all the articles and amendments. As a hunter, I am very much in support of the Second Amendment, but have sworn an oath to protect ever one of them.

Commissioner Cramer said she takes her job as Commissioner very seriously and also noted when she was sworn in January 6, 2020, her oath required her to protect the Constitution of the United States and the state of Pennsylvania.

Mr. Sellars asked if they would not do the resolution, what would the next step be. Commissioner Smith said go to your legislators and ask them to pass a law to protect their rights.

Solicitor Kay offered a summary of how the County operates and the Commissioners responsibilities. Solicitor Kay noted that Article 6, Clause 2 of the United State Constitution, known as the Supremacy Clause, means Congress passes the law of the land. The Commissioners cannot pass anything that disobeys these. Mr. Sellars ask what is wrong with adopting a resolution as the other counties have. Solicitor Kay stated it is just lip service and would not mean anything in the court of law.

Mr. Corbett said he was just asking for an affirmation of the Seconded Amendment to have in Harrisburg to take to the state and federal representatives. Commissioner Smith said take me with you.

New Business

The Commissioners held an employee anniversary recognition to recognize the following County employees who were in attendance:

The Commissioners thanked them for their dedicated service and look forward to many more years with them working for the County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to adopt the Proclamation for CASUAL (Colon Cancer Awareness Saves Unlimited Adult Lives) Day. The proclamation designates March as Colon Rectal Awareness Month and March 25, 2021 at CASUAL Day in Wayne County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to execute a letter to the PA Office of the Budget requesting a six-month extension on behalf of the Hawley Silk Mill Business Expansion Initiative II project in Hawley.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to execute and accept a Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency subgrant award for \$91,950 for the Wayne County District Attorney Office’s Victim/Witness Program.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to execute an application for \$74,796 for the Wayne County Probation

Department's Grant-In-Aid Program through the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to execute renewal for a State Offender Supervision Fund Agreement for FY 20-21.

The Chief Clerk noted that the two vacancies on the NEPA Alliance Board as of July 1 resulted from the untimely death of Mark Graziadio and the decision of Dave Hoff not to seek another term. The Board wants to replace them with people in the same field. The Commissioners are recommending the NEPA Alliance approve Jim Hockenbury to fill Dave Hoff's seat and Mike Rollison to fill Mark Graziadio's seat. A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Smith, with Commissioner Cramer abstaining because she is married to Mike Rollison, to recommend to the NEPA Alliance that they consider appointing Jim Hockenbury, Director of Ancillary Services at Wayne Memorial Hospital and Michael Rollison, local commercial lender, to terms on the NEPA Alliance Board of Directors, effective July 1, 2021. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to enter into a lease agreement with TDRS Properties, LLC, 18 Riverside Drive, White Mills, PA, for a parcel of land in Texas Township to be used as part of a proposed trail system. George Brown and Dan Corrigan, with the Wayne/Pike Waterways Trails Alliance, said they support this plan and are glad to see the County behind their efforts and to see this trail system progressing. Solicitor Kay noted it is approximately a 10.5 acre parcel of land they own. Commissioner Adams said it is great to be able to provide the public with accessibility to the river. The lease is for 25 years with a total cost of \$1.00 to the County with an additional renewal option of 25 years. The Commissioners are very excited about it and see a need and demand for this throughout the County.

Wayne County Director of Tax Services Cheryl Davies and Mary Noldy, Project Manager from Tyler Technologies, were present to discuss the County's pending reassessment plan. Mary Noldy said the purpose of the reassessment is to restore fairness and equality to the tax payers of Wayne County. There are some who may overpay and some who underpay. This will correct the disparity. This will not create a windfall for the County. Commissioner Smith noted it will not raise taxes. We are making things fair. Commissioner Adams said a previous bond issue will help pay for this. They are not raising taxes. To do so, the plan is to have a reassessment completed by the time the 2023 tax bills go out.

A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to execute a contract between Wayne County and Tyler Technologies in the amount of \$1,288,000 to perform a countywide reassessment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to execute a contract between Wayne County and Grandjean & Braverman, Inc. to assist Tyler Technologies in performing the countywide reassessment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to send a joint letter, on behalf of seven (7) regional counties, to the Governor and Acting Secretary of Health regarding regional vaccination clinics. The Chief Clerk explained that having mass clinics 90 minutes or more away were not beneficial to counties like Wayne and would like to have more rural, but who have a good place to administer them.

A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to promote Abigail F. Haines, from Caseworker 1 to Caseworker 2 in Behavioral Health, effective April 5, 2021, as a result of her serving six months in the position and completing all applicable training.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to ratify the judicial promotion of Lisa Salak to the open position of Deputy Chief of Adult Probation, effective March 22, 2021.

At this time, the Commissioners recessed to hold a Salary Board meeting. See Salary Board minutes.

The Commissioners' meeting resumed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to hire Tara Gross as a Human Resource Analyst 1 with Wayne County Human Services, effective April 5, 2021.

At this time, the Commissioners recessed to hold a Salary Board meeting. See Salary Board minutes.

The Commissioners' meeting resumed.

Other Business

The Commissioners received a copy of the Treasurer's Report dated March 24, 2021.
