

The regular meeting of the Wayne County Commissioners was held on this date with Commissioner Brian W. Smith presiding. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith with Commissioner James Shook and Commissioner Jocelyn Cramer present.

The Commissioners were presented with a copy of the minutes from the meeting held March 30, 2023. A motion was made by Commissioner Shook, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to approve the minutes of the said meeting.

Agenda

Correspondence and Communications

Received a notice from CHA informing Wayne County that the New York State Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the PA Department of Transportation, intend to submit a Chapter 105 Permit application to PennDOT for a bridge rehabilitation project of Bridge Street over the Delaware River in Damascus Township.

Received the March 2023 Sheriff's Report from Sheriff Chris Rosler.

The Chief Clerk noted that Terence Campbell has declined the County's job offer to be a part-time Van Driver. He asked for a motion to rescind the employment offer. A motion was made by Commissioner Shook, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to rescind the employment offer.

The Commissioners received a letter of resignation from Pamela Vargas, Preventative Specialist with the Drug and Alcohol Commission, effective April 5, 2023. A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Shook and unanimous to accept this letter.

Received a notice from Woodland Design Associates, Inc., regarding a Chapter 105 Permit application to the PA Department of Environmental Protection, on behalf of Rivercrest Properties, Inc., in Palmyra Township.

New Business

The Commissioners held an employee anniversary recognition. The following County employees were in attendance:

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Jamie Knecht, Director of the Conservation District, introduced Keith Pierson, Resource Conservationist, for his 5 year anniversary with the County. Ms. Knecht said it is hard to find someone who can talk to people and stay level headed, but Mr. Pierson does that. He oversees the District Chapter 102 and 105 Programs and he does it very well. Commissioner Smith told Mr. Pierson he sees how he interacts with people who greet him. He is professional and considerate, but most important, he uses common sense. He told Mr. Pierson the County hit the jackpot when the County hired you. Mr. Pierson said he loves his job and he cannot express how proud he is to work for Wayne County and with his colleagues in the Conservation District. He said it is a great place to work. He enjoys coming to the office every day. Commissioner Cramer said there is a great group working at the Conservation District and how it is so great that Mr. Pierson is part of it. Commissioner Shook said he enjoys the employee recognition each week, as a Commissioner, because it is great to hear all of the stories about our employees, how they are here and what roll they play in our operation of the County.

Administrative Officer Carl Albright introduced Rosemary Polak, Van Driver, for her 1 year anniversary with the County. Mr. Albright said Ms. Polak has done a great job in her first year. She brings a spirit of kindness and compassion thanks to her previous experience as a Home Health Aide. The Commissioners said we have an excellent Transportation department. We are glad to have someone like her helping our elderly. Ms. Polak said she loves the people she serves. She cares for them a lot and it is one of the best jobs she had in her life.

Director Michele Minor-Wolf, Dave Mazzenga, Erika Thaxton and Debbie Cosentino, from the Victims Intervention Program (VIP), were on hand to talk about Sexual Assault Awareness Month and the efforts VIP has taken to combat it. Ms. Minor-Wolfe said this year's theme is "Healing Together". She said as a society we need to do better. She thanked the Commissioners for all they do and said she knows how much they care and she appreciates the fact that they have always been supportive of VIP and their mission. Mr. Mazzenga said VIP has had 365 new clients since July 1st and said there will be a Take Back the Night event on April 7th, at the Cooperage Project.

Commissioner Smith said the stories and the statistics that VIP shares are some of the most horrific that we hear as Commissioners. Commissioner Cramer said the difference that you and your staff make in the community has been amazing and she is grateful for what they do every day. Commissioner Shook said that he has seen employees dealing with domestic violence and he commends VIP for what they do. He knows it is not easy. A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Shook and unanimous to adopt the Sexual Assault Awareness Month Proclamation in Wayne County.

Children and Youth Services Administrator Roz Burke, Casework Manager Stephanie Bryant and District Attorney Alfred G. Howell were on hand for Child Abuse Prevention Month. Ms. Burke detailed Wayne County statistics on child abuse. In 2021, there was 25 substantial claims of abuse in Wayne County, 18 females and 7 males, but thankfully no fatalities. Ms. Bryant said we are seeing parent mental health issues and it's affecting us very hard in this County. She commended her department's intake unit where staffing is down 60%, but the staff has still given it their all to make sure children are safe. She urged the public to call their agency if they see or hear of any suspected abuse. District Attorney Howell said his office is humbled to work with Children and Youth Services and the Victim's Intervention Program. The work they put in is invaluable. He knows how overwhelmed they are.

Commissioner Smith said the work Children and Youth Services does is incredibly important. He has no doubt, without our staff, there would be children dying in this County. Commissioner Cramer and Commissioner Shook also praised the work Children and Youth

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Services does and said they are making a big difference and agreed with Commissioner Smith that the work they are doing is saving lives. A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Shook and unanimous to adopt the Child Abuse Prevention Month Proclamation in Wayne County.

The Chief Clerk noted that the folks from the 8-1-1 Safe Digging group were unable to attend, but thanked the Commissioners for their annual recognition in highlighting the importance of calling 8-1-1 before you dig. A motion was made by Commissioner Shook, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to adopt the 8-1-1 Safe Digging Month Proclamation in Wayne County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Shook and unanimous to approve an amended Veterans Trust Fund grant agreement No. DMVA 2022-085.1 extending the terms of the agreement six months through November 30, 2023.

A motion was made by Commissioner Shook, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to approve the Wayne County Historical Society's request to use the Old Stone Jail and Bethel School for open houses and tours on the following dates and times:

A motion was made by Commissioner Cramer, seconded by Commissioner Shook and unanimous to promote Jamiela Feldman to the position of full-time Correctional Officer at the Wayne County Correctional Facility, effective April 9, 2023.

The Commissioners' meeting resumed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Shook, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to promote Lisa Rovinsky to the position of Chief Clerk in the District Attorney's Office, effective April 17, 2023.
