Warden Kevin Bishop introduced Corrections Officer Jennifer Wormuth for her 5 years with the County. The Commissioners thanked Ms. Rutherford for learning new skills and her willingness to take on more responsibilities in a very busy office.

Tracy Schwarz, System Administrator of the Wayne County Library Association, thanked the Commissioners for allowing library representatives to attend and be recognized for the hard work they do day in and day out. Ms. Schwarz said the theme of National Library Week this year is “Creating Connections” and that is a great illustration of what libraries do. Libraries are community hubs and throughout the pandemic evolved in many ways. Ms. Schwarz thanked the Commissioners for their incredible support they have given the libraries. She thanked the Commissioners for their forward thinking and putting county money where their mouth is. Hawley Public Library Director Amy Keane told the Commissioners that without their support they could not stay open.

Commissioner Smith thanked everyone gathered for what they do and said you continue to improvise upon programs. You serve our youth, you serve our seniors, you provide technology and you obviously are not just books anymore. Commissioner Adams said the connection theme is appropriate. A lot of what you are doing is above and beyond what a library typically does and we appreciate the entire team throughout the County. Commissioner Cramer said this is money well spent in our community and she thanked everyone there for the important role they play in so many lives.

Children’s Librarian Betty Lawson said we all had to dig pretty deep to reinvent ourselves to over the past two years. A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to adopt the proclamation for National Library Awareness Week in Wayne County.

Michele Minor Wolf, Linda Gardepe, Chelsea Falotico, Diana Olivias, Mary Bauserman, Jennifer Grieiner and Michelle November, from the Victims Intervention Program, were present for the Sexual Assault Awareness Month proclamation.

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Michele Minor Wolf, Executive Director of the Victims Intervention Program, spoke about why it is important to talk about sexual assaults, even though it is not a pretty conversation. She said there are people out there available to help victims get through their experience. She gave out the 24-hour victim's hotline number and thanked the Commissioners for always helping them get the word out about their services. The Commissioners said the silver lining is there are so many who care and so many out there to work with these victims. Commissioner Smith said he is sorry it happens, but until there is a cure we know your services are needed. A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to adopt the proclamation for Sexual Assault Awareness Month in Wayne County.

Human Services Administrator Michelle Valinski, Service Program Specialist Dave Hartung, Program Specialist Cindy Batzel and County Caseworker Shannon Guinard were on hand along with Anthony Tirado. Mr. Tirado wanted to share his personal story about how he grew up in the system. He said he found it surreal to be sitting in the Children and Youth waiting room recently as a job applicant. He said when he was young he was in that same room for many different reasons. He said his personal experiences give him a bigger drive to do what he is doing and it has put himself in a position to help others just as he was helped. Mr. Tirado thinks about all the kids that were in the same position as he was. He said all it takes is someone to sway you one way or another. Luckily for him he swayed in the right direction. He said if he could go back and talk to his young self, he would tell himself how lucky he is to have the support he does and to realize the world is not against him. Mr. Tirado noted there are people who genuinely want to help. He said I have gone through the probation, Children and Youth Services, PATH, and Independent Living Program. He has a better understanding of how to help those he will be working with. He said he talked to some people and told them he was going for a job interview with Children and Youth Services and they asked him how he could go to work for kid snatchers. He told them that is not what they do. He was looking forward to changing that perception out there.

Ms. Batzel shared with him how proud she is. Her message to all the youth she deals with is to dream big and it brings her joy to see her message got through to Mr. Tirado. Ms. Valinski said she is very grateful for our entire staff every day and how glad she is to be part of it.

Commissioner Smith congratulated Mr. Tirado and said he is a survivor and a thriver of a system we watch very closely and are proud of and it reinforces our beliefs when we hear success stories like his. Commissioner Adams told Mr. Tirado he is going to create opportunities by helping others. He encourages him to keep as passionate and change lives like his was changed for the better. Commissioner Cramer thanked him for being here and being able to talk about his life experiences.

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A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to hire Anthony Tirado as a Social Services Aide 1 in Wayne County Children and Youth Services, effective April 25, 2022.
