The Commissioners thanked both employees for their hard work and effort with the past year. The Commissioners gave special recognition to Ms. Rickard for her special efforts with the relief food program and keeping Wayne Tomorrow moving forward through the pandemic.

Michelle Minor-Wolf, Director for the Victims Intervention Program, a group from VIP and the Wayne County System of Continuum were on hand. They noted that silhouettes were installed in the Courthouse Lobby for the month of October as visual reminders of the loss of life domestic violence in Wayne County has created. They thanked the County Commissioners for allowing them to do it again this year. The Commissioners thanked Ms. Minor-Wolf and her group for the hard work they do on a day-in day-out basis and noted that domestic violence has not stopped just because there is a pandemic. A motion was made by Commissioner

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Smith, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to adopt the proclamation for Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Wayne County.

Jim Koniarski, Gabrielle Gardner, Carol Neier, Faith Phillips, Kathy Wallace, Rebecca Shook, Allah Shook, Allison Chory and Becky Tyler were present to recognize October 4-10, 2020 as Mental Illness Awareness Week. JoAnna VanTine, Marie Onukiavage and Marybeth Koniarski, from the Wayne Pike Chapter of the National Alliance for Mental Illness, spoke about the stigma of mental health and how being in local organization meetings weekly has made a difference for those struggling with mental health issues on their own or with family members and friends. Commissioner Adams noted that the request by the group to light the Courthouse green for the week of October has been approved as a show of support for everything the organizations do. A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to adopt the proclamation for Mental Illness Awareness Week in Wayne County.

Boy Scout Delimar Hugg, from Troop 1 in Honesdale, was attending the Commissioners meeting to accomplish a requirement for earning his Communication Merit Badge. The Commissioners thanked him for being a member of scouting and sitting through the meeting. They hoped he would continue throughout the path of becoming an Eagle Scout and wished him well in all of his endeavors.

A motion was made by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Adams and unanimous to increase the refrigerant evacuation fee at the Wayne County Recycling Center to \$15.00 per item effective October 5, 2020.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Cramer and unanimous to approve an amendment to the 2020 General Fund Budget to allocate payroll taxes, healthcare costs and the county pension contribution to all appropriate cost center. This is reallocating existing budget items to other line items, making this net neutral.

Sara Hailstone, County Consultant who was hired to assist with the CARES Act and small business grants was on hand to explain how the process has worked and how the review scoring and ranking system took place. Ms. Hailstone also noted the County budget is \$2.6 million, but the applications totaled more than \$10 million and some difficult decisions had to be made. Commissioner Adams credited Ms. Hailstone for her knowledge, guidance and financial expertise. Commissioner Cramer thanked her fellow Commissioners and Ms.

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Hailstone for making sure the available money was best allocated. The Chief Clerk explained the process going forward and how the awards will be announced to those who received them. The Chief Clerk complimented all involve for their speed and efficiency over the course of less than two months from announcing the application process to approving the awards.

A motion was made by Commissioner Adams, seconded by Commissioner Smith and unanimous to approve the 147 CARES Act allocations totaling \$2,570,058 to businesses and non-profits in Wayne County.
