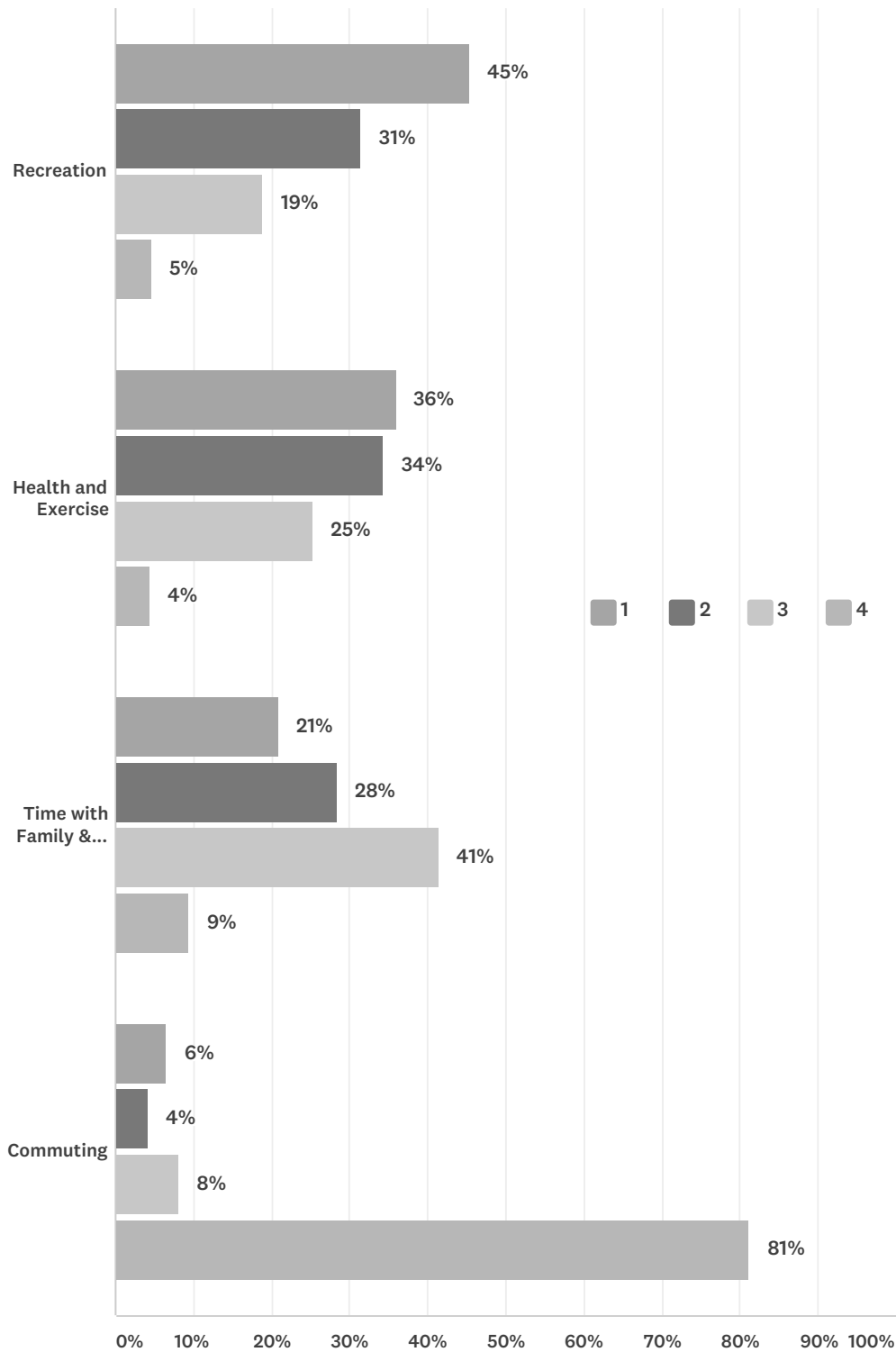
Q4 Of the following, what outdoor activities do you regularly participate in? (Choose all that apply)

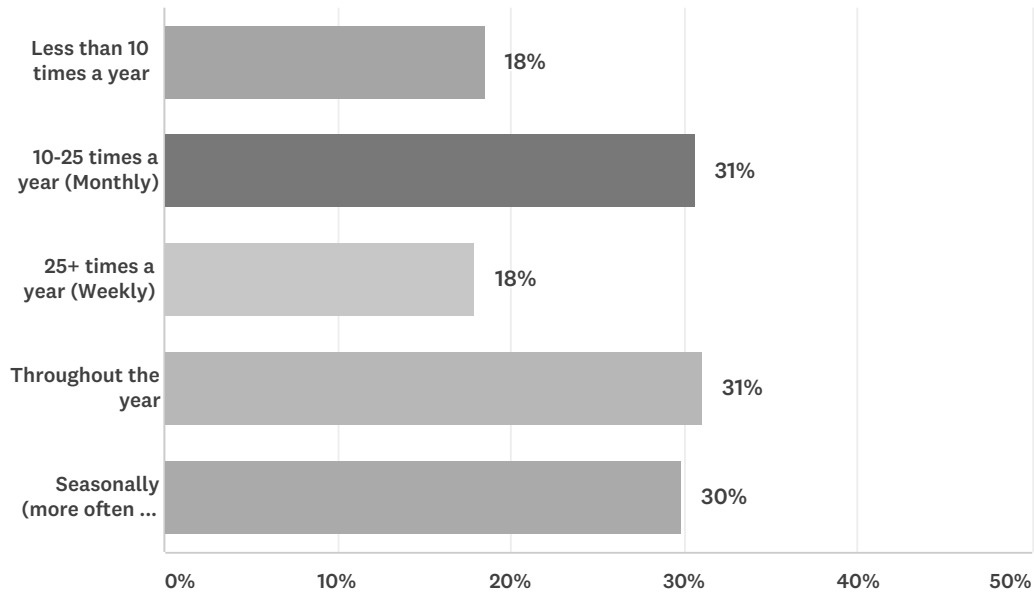
Q5 Please rank the following uses of a multi-use trail to your preference 1 (most preferred) - 4 (least preferred).

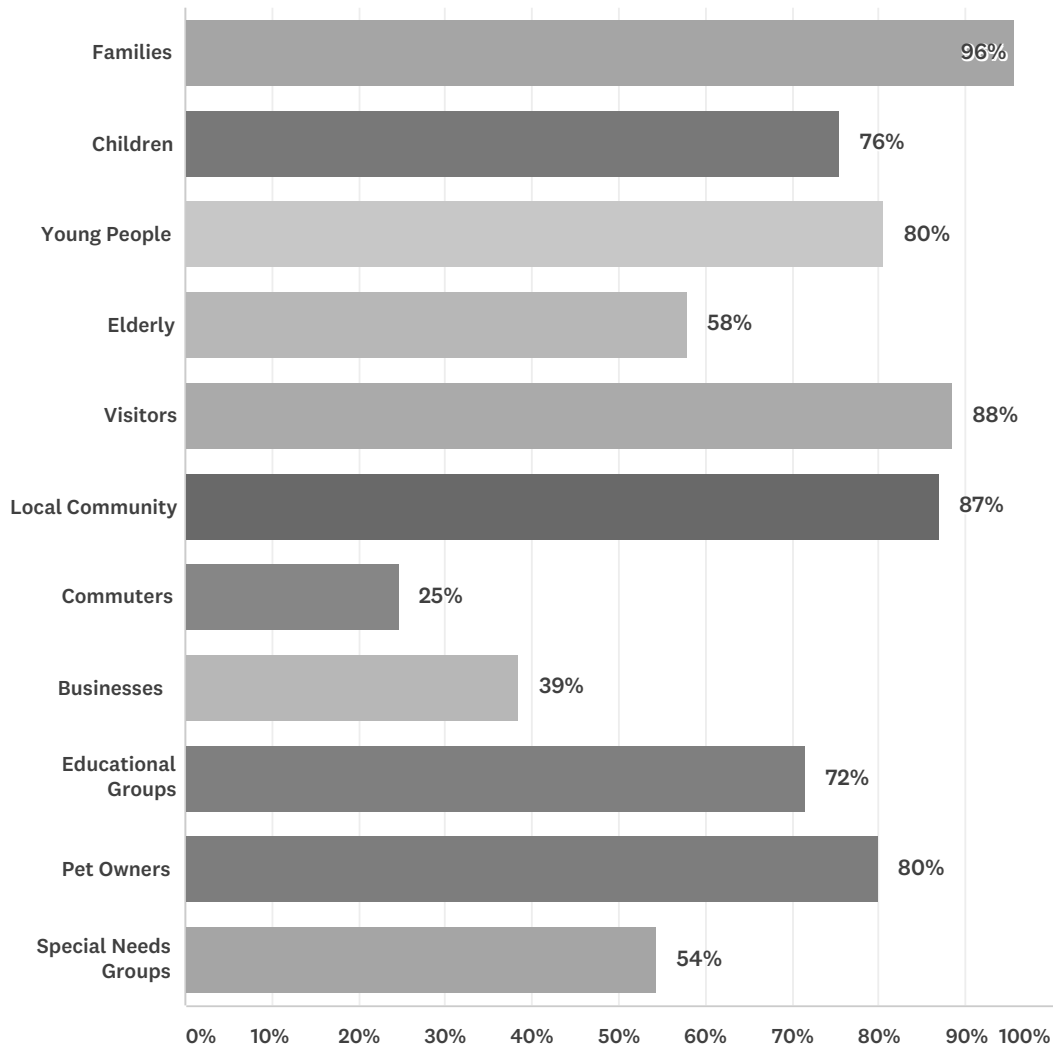
Q6 If a multi-use trail were present along the Lackawaxen River corridor connecting Honesdale & Hawley, how often and when would you use it? (Choose all that apply)

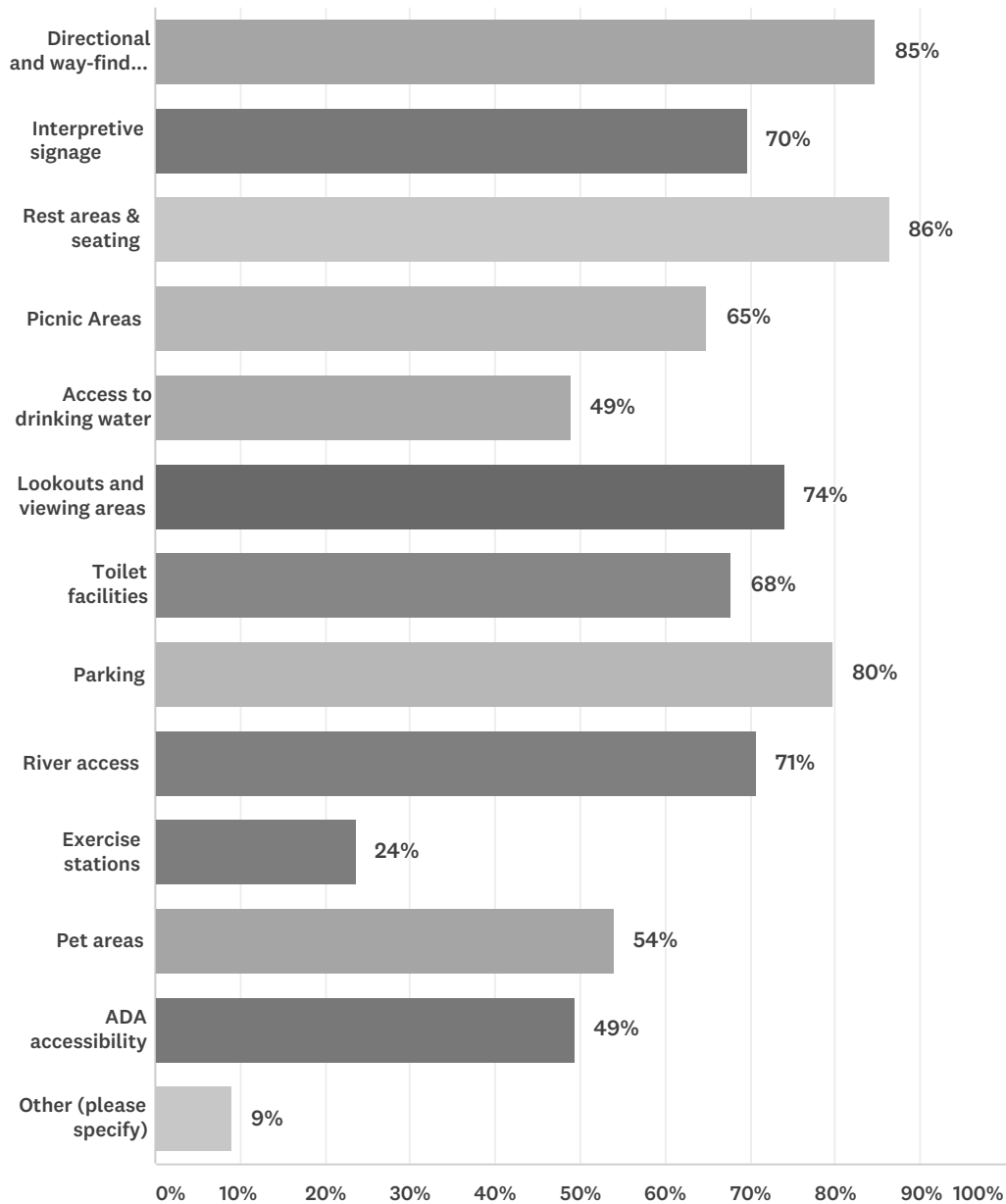
Q7 Who do you believe would benefit from a multi-use trail along the Lackawaxen River Corridor connecting Honesdale & Hawley? (Choose all that apply)

As an owner of approximately one mile of land along the Stourbridge Line tracks I worry about a number of issues regarding the proposed trail system. I was born in Honesdale, and the property I now own has been in the Masker family since about 1925. Our land provides a good bit of the scenic beauty exploited by the Stourbridge Railroad as they entice potential ticket buyers. The ground provides largely undisturbed haven and refuge for wildlife. Thus, while the railroad has made, and (to a lesser extent) continues to make, valuable contributions to our area, a trail would invite further intrusion in the form of foot traffic, pets, and possibly horses (or motorized conveniences i.e. ATVs, snowmobiles even if these are designated as restricted). This has potential for severe negative impact. The availability of relatively extensive tracts of undeveloped land provide the real value here. As these lands are subject to more disruption they become less of a resource. Deer, rabbits, and coyotes may live in residents' back yards, but wildlife such as bear, turkey, bobcat, and eagles need their space. A trail system that would invite increased human presence near or on our land raises concerns as to loss of privacy, noise, more trash, increased trespassing (already an issue), safety during the hunting season, and higher risk of liability. Who would police and maintain the proposed trail?

Discussions at the February 6 meeting made valid and largely well articulated arguments as to the benefits of a trail system to our community. But, it must be emphasized that the proposed trail will penetrate private land and the land owners who provide the major benefit by keeping their lands undeveloped and in a more natural state will suffer the consequences of higher traffic through their lands even if only a small fraction of those who use the trail behave irresponsibly. Public tracts of land such as are provided by Pennsylvania state forests and state game lands would seem more appropriate for a recreational trail. There the benefits and risks would be spread over the public at large. Missing from the survey is a question as to "what would you be willing to pay or sacrifice in order to have a trail along the river?" The claimed 92% of respondents who favor building a trail is skewed by lack of cost or even effort to most respondents. Some of these may even harbor a sense of entitlement that they, as taxpayers, could legitimately feel if the trail intruded into only public land.

If the trail is built (as I hope it will not) I'd like to see a minimum of facilities. I have hiked a lot of trails, and my experience has been that foot traffic drops off sharply after a mile or so from the parking lot. My prejudice is that folks who hike further seem to have a greater sense of responsibility regarding their intrusion into nature. Also, the committee might consider shorter trails originating from either or both Honesdale or Hawley. Demonstrated lack of problem or experience solving these problems on an abbreviated version of the proposed trail system might even attenuate resistance by affected property owners. Finally, let me emphasize my appreciation for the way this inquiry is being handled. The Feb 6 meeting was indeed a study of democracy in action. Everyone is being given a chance to express their viewpoints and all are doing so in a way that is respectful of others who may disagree. Bringing groups who want to protect wetlands, trout streams, and other natural resources into the discussion reinforces the sense that this is being handled with the best interests of the community as a whole in mind.
