





- Rehabilitation grants/loans for landlords




17) Do you favor the development of alternative energy sources such as wind, solar and hydro-electric within Wayne County?


18) If yes, do you believe municipalities should develop regulations that would provide for these uses by landowners while protecting neighbors from any negative spillover impacts?


19) Are you interested in developing any of these energy sources on your own property?

20) Would you object if your neighbor developed any of these resources, assuming the proper regulations are in place to protect your property from any negative spillover impacts?








23) Which of the following best describes how you feel the prospects may be if you were to search for new and better employment in Wayne County.
